SCDEW Joins SCBOS in Providing More Services to SC Businesses

The SC Department of Employment and Workforce (SCDEW) is now partnering with the SC Business One-Stop(SCBOS) to offer more convenient, web-based services to the state's business community.

SCDEW is working closely with the SC Department of Revenue and other partners in SCBOS, South Carolina's official full-time business web portal, which allows business owners to file permits, licenses, registrations and to pay taxes on-line.

Under the new system, registered employers can now file their quarterly wage reports and have their unemployment taxes quickly calculated and reported to them in seconds. Employers will have the option to pay their taxes on-line by way of electronic funds transfer. Businesses without an account number can go on-line and register at www.scbos.sc.gov. A SCDEW account number will generally be assigned to an employer within two business days of receipt of a completed application if it is determined the employer met the state's established liability requirements.
